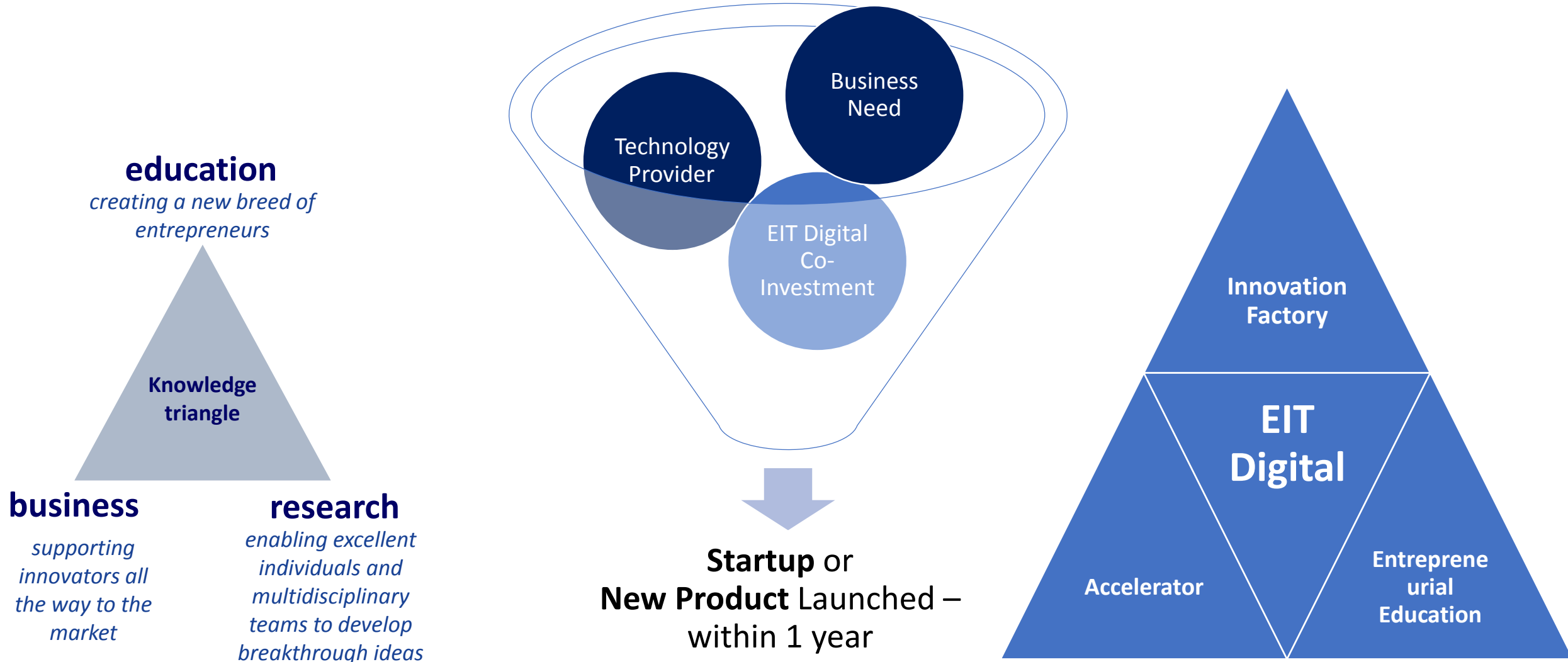

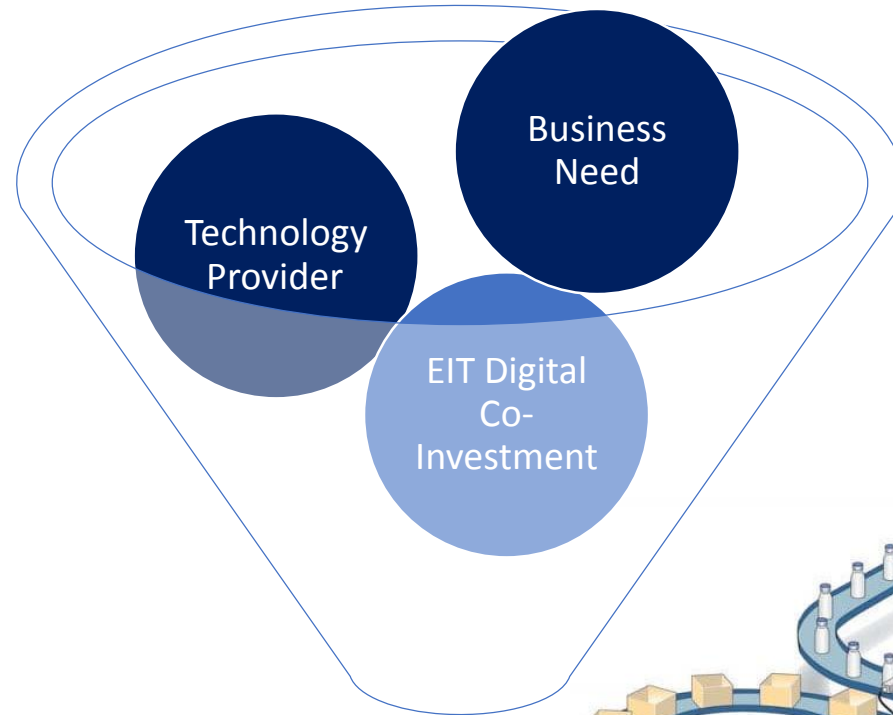

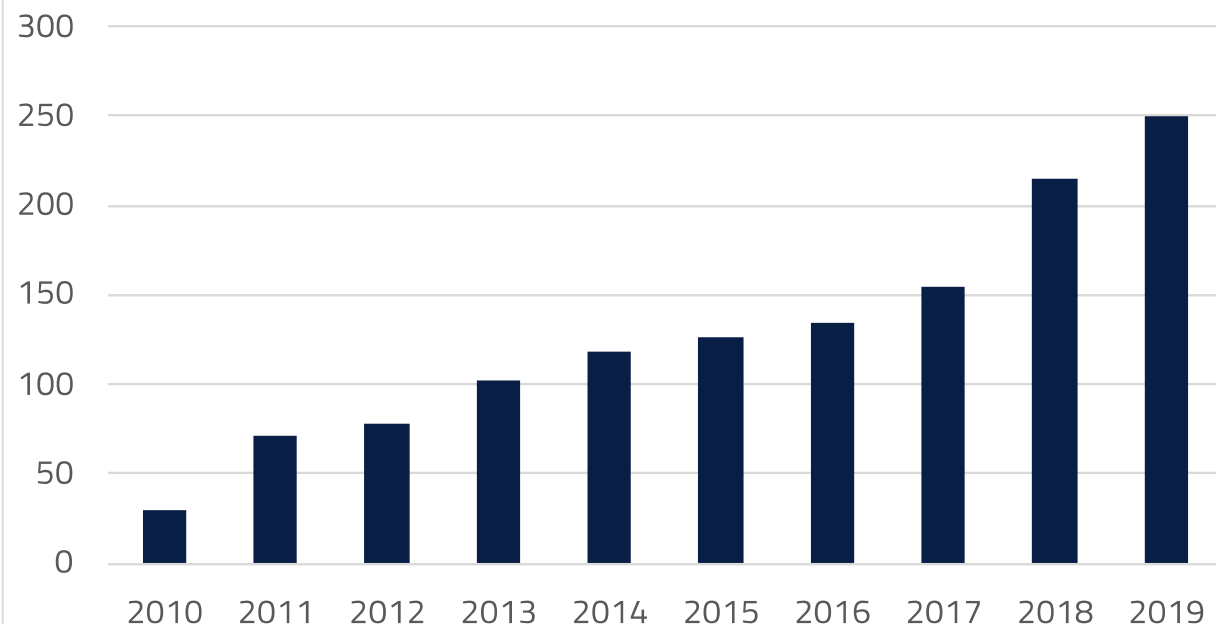

2010: 5 Nodes

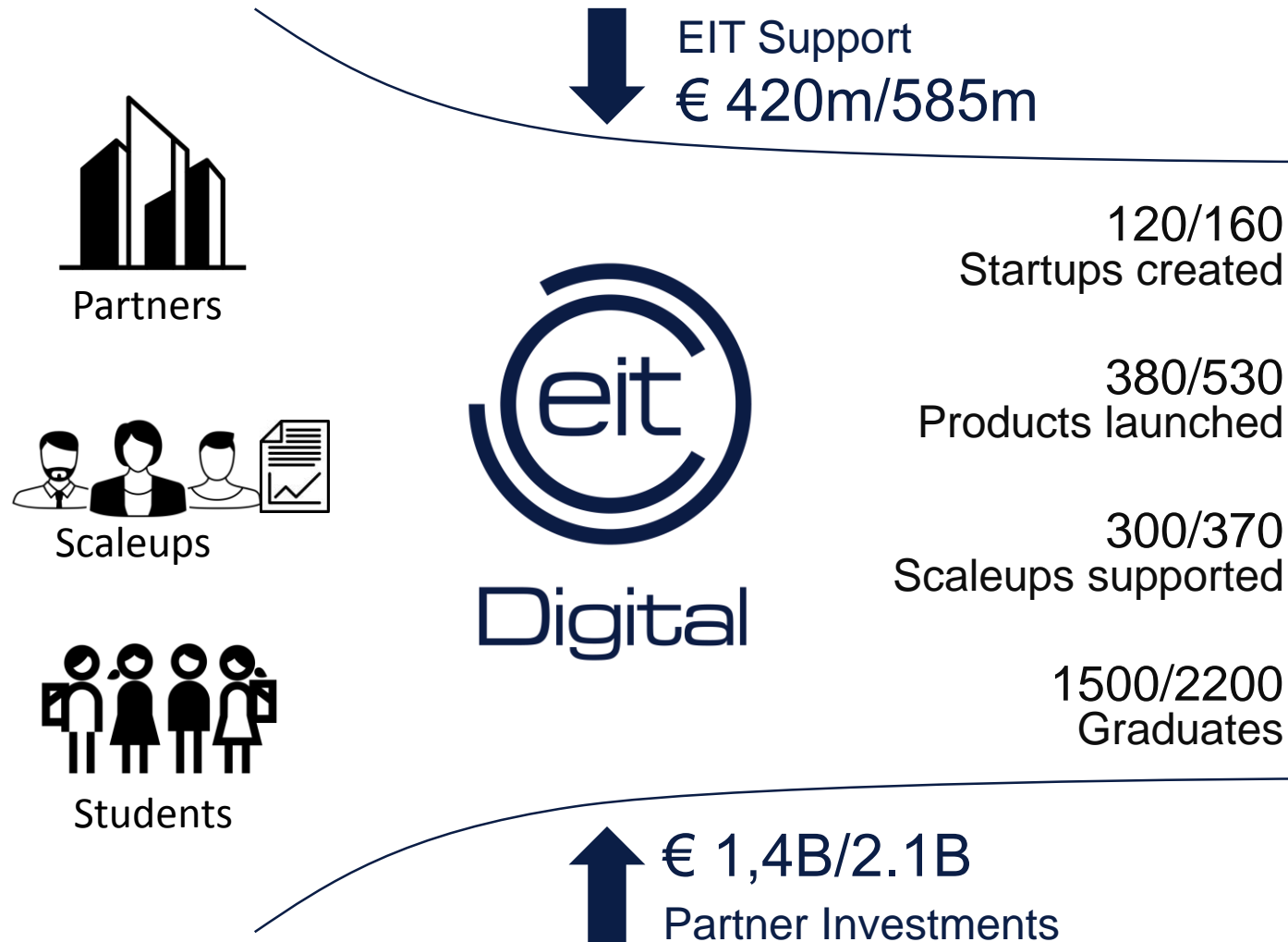
2012: Trento becomes a Full Node
